PROGRAM

Philippe Druelle D.O., MRO is the founder of College d'Etudes Osteopathique (Canadian College of Osteopathy) in Montreal, the Canadian Foundation for Teaching and Research in Osteopathy which treats children with serious neurological issues. He has developed programs for 32 different International Symposiums on Osteopathy. He has published articles in The French Review of Neonatology and Pediatrics. He is the director and project advisor for the first full time program leading to a Diploma BSc (Hons) in Osteopathy Canada , through the University of Wales. He is a leading expert in traditional osteopathy and has taught and presented his cutting edge research and treatment approach throughout the world. Dr. Viola Frymann DO, FAAO, FCA has recognized Philippe as one of the leading practitioners and innovators in field of osteopathy today.

Introduction:

- Work of Dr. Charlotte Weaver, D.O. including use of the cranial vertebrae in evaluating and treating genetic, cerebral, and neuro-vascular anomalies
- Adaption of Osteopathic techniques for infants and small children
- Osteopathic visceral techniques for the neonate which address the liver, lungs, and heart

3) **Resolving Birth Trauma: The Physical Aspect**

- Learn implications of and techniques to address the “Birth Spiral”
- Learn the precise patterns and precautions that must be taken to adequately resolve birth trauma
- Advanced applications and methods of “molding” technique as presented by Dr. Schooley, Dr. Sutherland, and Dr. Frymann
